



Process for recording the hydroxychloroquine screening by SpaMedica on system1 and emis web clinical systems in General Practice.

Upon receipt of a letter from SpaMedica to inform the practice that that retinopathy screening has been done for patients who are prescribed hydroxychloroquine, you should add a read/snomed code entry into the patient's consultation record for future reference. This will ensure appropriate monitoring and review in the future.

System1

Log into the patient's record and open a new consultation. In the 'examination' tab type **Snomed code 1104901000000103 for hydroxychloroquine retinopathy monitoring**. Click this and click save, it will then be added into the patient's record.

Emis web

Log into the patient's record and open new consultation, click on comment, type **'Hydroxychloroquine retinopathy screening'** then click save, it will then be added into the patient's record.
