

Type 2 Diabetes meter review

In June 2025, NHS updated the guidance for patients using blood glucose meters and test strips, a national assessment was undertaken to better understand the products available and how they meet the needs of all people living with diabetes.

The new guidance will ensure that people living with diabetes have continued access to clinically effective meters and test strips.
