Definitions

Research

designed and conducted to generate new knowledge

Audit

designed to find out whether the quality of a service meets a defined standard

Service evaluation

designed to answer the question
“What standard does this service achieve?”

Quality Improvement

continuous actions to improve outcomes for service users and to develop the workforce that supports using systematic methods (NHSE - Quality Improvement Framework)
